

Dear BRAKING AIDS® Ride Participant,

The Ride is coming! We can't wait to see you in Philadelphia (or for 1-Day Riders, in Princeton!).

This packet contains a wealth of information for both 2-Day and 1-Day Riders and Crew, as well as forms that you need to return to us by <u>Friday</u>, <u>August 2</u>, <u>2024</u>. Please print out this entire document for your reference. Here is what is included:

- <u>Travel Info</u>. Options to get yourself and your bike to Philadelphia or back to Philadelphia after Ride.
- <u>Travel Reservation Form</u>. Riders and Crew can make all your reservations <u>using this link</u>. While we are covering the cost of your travel this year, it is still essential that you tell us which options you are using.
- <u>Medical Form and Waiver</u>. All participants both Riders and Crew must complete and return this form so that we may best take care of you during the Ride.
- Policies and Protocols. All participants Riders and Crew must complete and return this form.
- <u>Bike Tune-Up Checklist</u>. Make sure your bike is in top form before the Ride. Take it to a bike shop you trust (perhaps one of the Official Outfitters listed at www.brakingaidsride.org). Have it checked out and tuned up within a month before the Ride. Take the checklist with you to the shop.
- <u>In Memoriam</u>. Email us a **photo** of each friend you'd like to commemorate, along with their names.
- Starting Location. Arch Street Meeting House, 320 Arch Street, Philadelphia, PA 19106.
- **2-Day Host Hotel** (Friday night). Our host hotel is the Wyndham Philadelphia Historic District, 400 Arch Street, Philadelphia, PA 19106. You do NOT need to make a reservation, but you DO need to tell us if you're staying there. Details on page 3.
- <u>Crew Meeting Location</u>. The Crew meeting will be held at the Arch Street Meeting House, 320 Arch Street, Philadelphia, PA 19106.
- <u>1-Day Host Hotel</u> (Saturday night). Our host hotel is the Doubletree Hotel Princeton, 4355 US Route 1, Princeton, NJ 08540. You do NOT need to make a reservation, but you DO need to tell us if you're staying there. Details on page 3.

PRE-RIDE GUIDE



All 2-Day riders and crew must arrive in Philadelphia, PA for registration on Friday, September 13th – Crew by 3:00 PM, Riders by 6:00 PM. NEW THIS YEAR: We will offer transportation for you, your bike, and your gear to Philadelphia. NEW THIS YEAR: We will provide lodging for Friday night! However, even though they are included, you must sign up for transportation, bike shipping, and Friday night hotel using this link. This Pre-Ride Guide will keep it simple. Send in your completed form by Friday, August 2nd.

1a. Bike Shipping (2-Day Riders)

We offer bike shipping through McCollister's Trucking Company. McCollister's is a reputable company that has provided bike shipping for us for two decades. Each bike is insured for up to \$500. Bike shipping may NOT be reserved on-site on September 13th. NEW THIS YEAR: We are offering this transportation to you free of charge. However, you must reserve using this link.

On Friday, September 13th, bring your bike to the truck parked outside 357 W. 44th Street, New York, NY 10036 (just east of Ninth Avenue), between 2:00 pm and 3:30 pm. Your bike will be arrive in Philadelphia at roughly the same time as you. Please do not disassemble your bike, but do remove water bottles, your bike computer, mounted pump, etc.

1b. Bike Rentals

For out-of-town riders, we offer bike rentals via Unlimited Biking. The cost is the same for both 1-Day and 2-Day Riders. You can rent your bike here: https://unlimitedbiking.com/events/braking-aids-ride/.

2-Day Riders: If you are taking our bus to the event from New York City (see Section 2 below), please arrive at 357 W. 44th Street, New York, NY 10036 no later than 3:15 pm in order to be fitted to your bike. If you are arriving at Registration Eve on your own, your rental bike will arrive in Philadelphia with our Bike Shipping truck on Reg Eve.

1-Day Riders: Use the same portal to rent your bike. We will ensure that your bike is waiting for you when you arrive in Princeton!

All Riders: Unlimited Biking will pick your bike up from the Closing Ceremony site at Riverbank State Park on Sunday, September 15.

2. 2-Day Participant Travel to Philadelphia for Registration Eve

Travel from New York City

We have chartered a bus from New York City to Philadelphia. **NEW THIS YEAR:** We are offering this transportation to you free of charge. However, you must reserve using this link. No tickets will be sold on September 13th. If you prefer, a friend may drop you off in Philadelphia. However, your car may NOT be left on site during the two days of the event.

Riders: The bus will depart on Friday, September 13th at 4:00 pm. Destination: Arch Street Meeting House (Registration Eve site).

Buses will depart from outside 357 W. 44th Street, New York, NY 10036 (just east of Ninth Avenue). Please arrive at least 30 minutes prior to departure to drop your bike. The trip takes approximately 2 hours.

Crew: Vans will depart from outside 357 W. 44th Street, New York, NY 10036 (just east of Ninth Avenue) on Friday, September 13th at 1:00 pm. The trip takes approximately 2 hours.

Alternatively, Amtrak offers service to Philadelphia. Note that Amtrak has limited options to bring a bike; check Amtrak.com for details. 30th Street Station is approximately 2.5 miles (20 minute bike ride) from the ceremony site.

3. 1-Day Rider Travel to Princeton on Saturday, September 14th.

We will offer a shuttle and bike shipping from Manhattan to Princeton on Saturday, September 14th for our 1-Day Riders. This transportation is offered free of charge, but you must reserve in advance <u>using this link</u>.

The shuttle will depart on Saturday, September 14th at 4:00 pm from outside 357 W. 44th Street, New York, NY 10036 (just east of Ninth Avenue).

Destination: Doubletree Hotel Princeton, 4355 US Route 1, Princeton, NJ 08540.

The shuttle will depart. Please arrive with your bike at least 15 minutes prior to departure. The trip takes approximately 90 minutes.

Alternatively, New Jersey Transit offers service to Princeton Junction, approximately 5 miles from our Saturday night hotel. You may ride your bike or Uber from the Princeton Junction train station to the hotel.

Please come and cheer the 2-Day Riders as they make their way to the host hotel! Then join us for dinner at 6:30 pm at the hotel on Saturday evening and stay the night – it's all included with your fundraising!

4. Dinner, Friday, September 13th

During Registration Eve, we will offer a buffet dinner at the Registration Eve site. This full buffet will offer you the opportunity to sit with new and old friends as you fuel up for the Ride! **NEW THIS YEAR: Registration Eve dinner is included!**

5. Accommodation, Friday, September 13th

Our host hotel will be the Wyndham Philadelphia Historic District. **NEW THIS YEAR:** Friday night host hotel is included (double occupancy); however, you must still let us know by August 2 if you need a room. Reserve accommodation using this link. Make your reservation before August 2nd, as the remaining rooms in our block will be released at that time.

MEDICAL WAIVER

All participants, please read this:

WAIVER OF NEGLIGENCE & COMPLETE RELEASE OF LIABILITY

I wish to participate in BRAKING AIDS® Ride which I understand to be a two-day, 175-mile non-competitive donation bicycle ride and related events. I understand that in participating in BRAKING AIDS® Ride I will be using public streets and facilities where many hazards exist and I am aware of and appreciate the risks which may result. I am also aware that accidents occur during such activities and that I may be seriously injured or killed as a result. I am voluntarily participating in this event with knowledge of the dangers involved and I agree to accept any and all risks of injury or death.

In consideration for being permitted to participate in BRAKING AIDS® Ride, I agree to assume all risks and to release and hold harmless Housing Works; Bailey House; Global Impact Productions dba Global Impact Tours Inc., BRAKING AIDS® Ride, all BRAKING AIDS® Ride Medical Team members, sponsors, officials, participating clubs, communities, organizations and all other government or public entities (and all of their respective officers, directors, agents, employees and members) who, through negligence, carelessness or any other cause, might otherwise be liable to me.

I intend by this Waiver and Release to release, in advance, and to waive my rights and discharge all of the persons and entities mentioned above, from any and all claims for damages for death, personal injury or property damage which I may have, or which may hereafter accrue to me, as a result of my participation in BRAKING AIDS[®] Ride, even though that liability may arise from negligence or carelessness on the part of the persons or entities being released, from dangerous or defective property or equipment owned, maintained or controlled by them or because of their possible liability without fault. I understand and agree that this Waiver and Release is binding on my heirs, assigns and legal representatives.

I am physically capable of participating in BRAKING AIDS[®] Ride, and my medical care provider has approved my participation. If I am aware of or under treatment for any physical infirmity, ailment or illness, my medical care provider knows of and has approved my participation in BRAKING AIDS[®] Ride. If I have been diagnosed with any psychological conditions, my mental health provider knows of and has approved my participation in BRAKING AIDS[®] Ride. I acknowledge that I, and I alone, am solely responsible for my personal health and safety and the personal property I bring with me. I acknowledge that the medical insurance information I have provided on the Medical Form is current and complete. I accept full responsibility for any costs incurred for medical treatment due to incorrect, outdated, or falsified insurance information. I will read the BRAKING AIDS[®] Ride description and rules for participation in BRAKING AIDS[®] Ride and I will abide by all rules and regulations established by the BRAKING AIDS[®] Ride organizers and personnel as well as the bicycling codes of New York State, Pennsylvania and New Jersey.

I understand that my name, photograph, voice, video and film image, or likeness may be used by Housing Works, Global Impact Tours Inc., Black Watch Productions, Alan Barnett Photography, their licensees, affiliates and employees. I consent to and authorize, in advance, such use and waive my rights of privacy I have in connection therewith.

I have carefully read this Waiver and Release and fully understand its contents. I certify that I am at least 18 years of age at time of registration. I am aware that this is a RELEASE OF LIABILITY and a contract between me and the persons and entities mentioned above and all of their respective officers, director, employees, agents and representatives and I sign it of my own free will.

Policies and Protocols

The policies and protocols below have been established to maximize the safety and enjoyment of BRAKING AIDS® Ride ("the Ride") for all participants. Please sign and return this form to the BRAKING AIDS® Ride office by Friday, August 2nd, 2024.

- 1. I understand that I must obey all laws, including traffic laws, during BRAKING AIDS® Ride. I will follow Ride participation instructions from all Ride personnel, including Global Impact Productions staff, staff of Housing Works, and volunteer Crew members. Medical personnel and bicycle technicians may suspend my right to ride or crew if they deem my physical condition, or my bicycle's condition, unfit to continue.
- 2. I am required to attend an official Safety Presentation in Philadelphia on Registration Eve on Friday, September 13th, 2024 (2-Day Riders) or in Princeton on Saturday evening, September 14th, 2024 (1-Day Riders) before participating in the Ride, and will abide by the policies and procedures described.
- 3. While on my bike, I will:
 - a. Wear a helmet, properly fastened on my head, at all times.
 - b. Refrain from using headphones or earphones.
 - c. Refrain from using a cell phone, smart phone or other handheld device.
- 4. Consumption of alcoholic beverages is strictly prohibited beginning on Friday evening, September 13th and continuing until the end of the Closing Ceremony on September 15th. Possession or use of illegal drugs or unauthorized transfer of prescription medication is similarly prohibited.
- 5. The success of the Ride is based upon the principle of mutual respect among all participants. In that spirit, I may not antagonize, harass, or jeopardize the safety of any Ride personnel, including Global Impact Productions staff, staff of Housing Works, riders and/or volunteer Crew members.

Failure to abide by these policies and protocols will result in disciplinary action that may include, at BRAKING AIDS® Ride staff's discretion, my expulsion from the Ride.
